Beneath the jungle of Mexico's Yucatan Peninsula, a labyrinth of underground waterways has formed in the porous limestone bedrock. In areas where the ground has eroded and collapsed in on itself, giant sinkholes, known as cenotes, have formed. Follow your guide from Cenote Dive Centre on a tour into the blackness, exploring vast chambers, giant limestone pillars and narrow swim-throughs before surfacing in the shallow sandy grotto at the far end.
